Rules and Standards**

Contestant / Parent / Guardian Agreement

I, the Contestant/Parent/Guardian, fully understand and agree to the following:

1. I have read the attached rules and understand the decisions of the judges are final.
2. I am responsible for returning all proceeds and documents from raffle ticket sales. The winner in each category will be determined by the dollar amount raised from ticket sales in combination with pageant point system. Each contestant must sell at least \$200 in raffle tickets, with each dollar raised over \$200 contributing to points in pageant.
3. If chosen as Miss Piikani Nation, Miss Jr. Piikani Nation, or Little Miss Piikani Nation, I will fully participate in all days of the Piikani Nation Powwow and assist with any activities as requested, such as raffle ticket sales, 50/50 raffle sales, and/or blanket dances during the Powwow.
4. If chosen, I will wear my crown and sash when participating in Grand Entry at the Piikani Nation Powwow and at all other Powwows that I will attend in the future.
5. If chosen, I will do my best to be a positive role model; I will always represent Piikani Nation with respect and honor.
6. I will be on time at all Grand Entries not chew gum or engage in horseplay in any the Grand Entry.
7. I understand PRDL will announce one (1) winner and two (2) runners-up for Miss Piikani Nation. Piikani Nation will announce only one (1) winner and one (1) runner-up for each Miss Jr. Piikani Nation, and Little Miss Piikani Nation.
8. In the event of a tie, in any contestant category, the contestants will be asked one question by the judges. The decision of the judges will be final.
9. If I engage in any behavior that PRDL deems as disrespectful or undesirable or if I participate in any type of activity that questions my ability to represent Piikani Nation in a positive and honorable manner, (i.e. become pregnant, or get caught with drugs or alcohol) I may be asked to give up my title and crown by PRDL. Upon being asked to give up my title, I must return the Piikani Nation crown and sash. I will no longer be able to represent the Piikani Nation at any Pow Wows or other types of events.
10. Contestants may not hold any other titles while holding the Piikani Nation title; the contestant may not have any children, or be married.
11. If I am asked to give up my title, the runner up will assume the title for the remainder of the year.
12. I release PRDL and their agents, members, and representatives from any and all debts, claims, injuries, liabilities, personal property loss, and causes of action weather known or unknown.
13. Any and all photos/videos/media of contestants are owned by PRDL and may be utilized for public relations at any given time.

As the parent/guardian of the contestant named above I understand and agree to the terms above.
